Our budding artists created several beautiful pieces of art on their own. Martina and Florentine painted the glass window of the class from their own imaginations. It looked so beautiful.

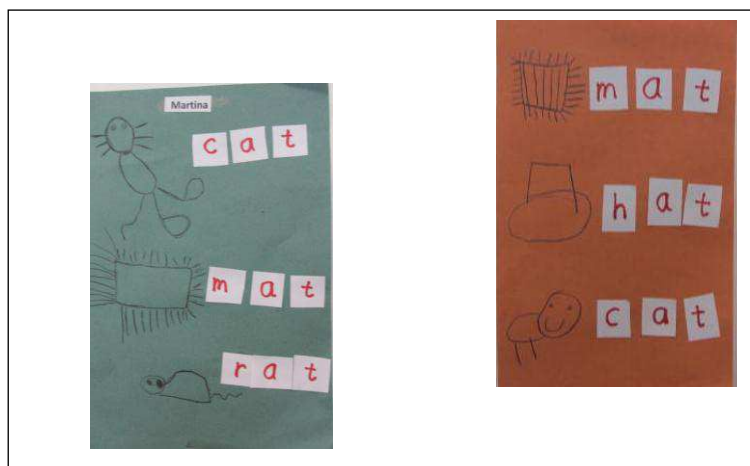




Children also created 'Starry Night' by using different art media – tempura paints, finger prints, crayons – they looked wonderful.

The children now know about the artists we have been discussing during the past few weeks. They have even started recognizing the styles of the artists. When they see dots they say 'it is Damian Hurst'!!! The letter 'v' was introduced. Now they have started recognizing sound of the first letter of a word. The group of older children has started writing the letters. In mathematics, we reinforced the 2D shapes. The children matched the numbers 1 to 10 both by quantity and symbols. They have also started backward counting, using their fingers.

We reinforced the letter 'm' this week. Some of the children used paint and brush to write 'm' on the easel. The older children started forming three letter phonic words. They found the correct letters and formed the words.

We had a very exciting last week of the term. Leonardo, the magician showed magic tricks in the class during his "show-and-tell" session. And we had special visitor, Parker's baby brother.
